Main Scripture: 1 Corinthians 2:7-13

Referenced Scripture: Acts 17:10-11, Matthew 26:39, Hebrews 4:12, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Proverbs 13:20,
Romans 1:17

OPEN:

1. What in particular spoke to you from Congressman Gohmert’s message?
2. What is it that leads you?

DIG DEEPER:

1. In **Corinthians 2:9-10** we find powerful scripture about the role of the Holy Spirit. What is the Lord showing you in this text?
2. Congressman Gohmert gave us three key points to apply in our lives that will help us to be ready to move when the Spirit moves. The first point was to *Seek God’s Will Daily*. What insight into this can you glean from the Bereans (**Acts 17:10-11**), and from Jesus (**Matthew 26:39**), which you can apply into your own life?
3. The second key point is *Make Sure It Is the Spirit Leading*. How will using scripture (**Hebrews 4:12**), prayer (**1 Thessalonians**), and wise counsel (**Proverbs 13:20**) help you to know it is the Spirit leading?
4. The final point is to *Have Faith; Step Forward* (**Romans 1:17**). In what way does it all come down to trusting God before we move when the Spirit moves? How have your own trust issues with God hindered you from moving when the Spirit is moving in you?

REFLECT:

1. Which of these three key points challenges you the most? How so?
2. How have you sensed the Holy Spirit moving you to do something in your life? What is that specific something and what is holding you back?
