Main Scripture: Luke 1:26-38, 2:1-11

Referenced Scripture: Hebrews 1:1-4, Exodus 33:18, Hebrews 11:39-40, Isaiah 60:1-7, Jude 24-25

OPEN:

1. What in particular spoke to you from Pastor Bob’s message?
2. How does knowing someone differ from knowing about someone?

DIG DEEPER:

1. In **Luke 2:7** we read a very familiar verse that reminds us that we must make room for Jesus in “the inn” of our hearts and not shut Him out. How might the one who only knew about Jesus respond to this, and what response would you expect from a true believer?
2. In what way do you see God getting personal with us in **Hebrews 1:2**?
3. In **Exodus 33:18** Moses is asking God, in essence, for a more intimate relationship with Him exceeding all previous revelations. Do you have a similar desire for the power, presence, purpose, and peace of God? Why or why not?
4. Have you ever really considered the depth of the glory of God? **Isaiah 60:1** should be of great encouragement. What is God’s glory? How does this verse encourage you?
5. What does **Jude 24-25** reveal about God’s heart? Where do you find both purpose and promise in this text?

REFLECT:

1. There was a time when you only knew *about* God. How did you come to know Him?
2. The highest calling on our lives is to know the Lord. What is He speaking into your heart about knowing Him more than ever before?

Philippians 3:10

“...that I may know Him and the power and His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.”
